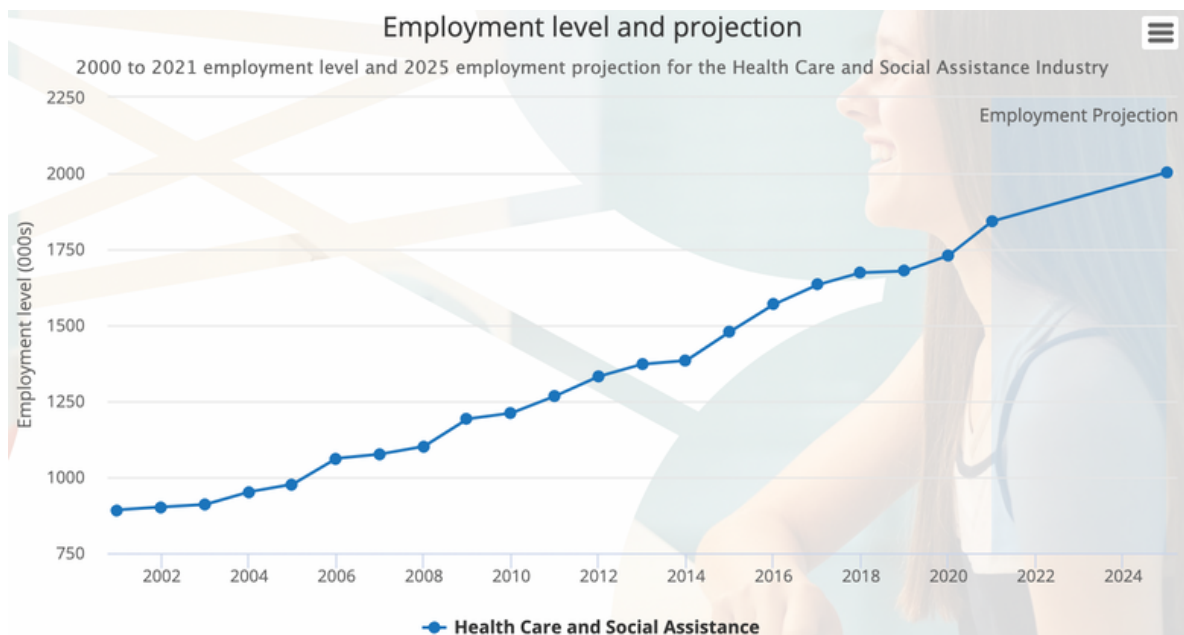

Entry Requirements

The target learner is typically an adult wanting to provide services and support to people in the health and client care industries. The target learner for this course must:

- Be over 15 years of age, and no longer attending secondary school
- Undertake a Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Skills Indicator
- Obtain security clearance*
- Access to a computer and with up-to-date software
- Be able to undertake 80 hours of vocational placement

Enrolment Requirements

- Proof of ID: Colour copy of Passport or Driver's Licence.
- Unique Student Identification Number (USI)
- Colour copy of Certificates and Statement Results for any previously attained or partially completed qualifications completed in or recognised in Australia.

**Security Clearance: Some qualifications require a security clearance (e.g., police check, valid blue card and/or yellow card) in order for the student to be eligible to undertake practical and/or vocational placement. Additionally, individual host organisations may have different requirements regarding vaccinations. Please discuss these with our Administration Team during the enrolment process and/or refer to the DP Training website for more information. Please note that there are mandatory vaccination requirements within each state. It is up to the student to comply with their state, territory legislation and workplace organisation policies and procedures.*

Vocational Placement

All students will be required to complete either a Vocational placement Log Book or, if an Existing worker, a Workplace log book of at least 80 hours of direct care within an approved health care, aged care facility or community services organisation. DP Training has a partnership with Leading Aged Care Providers with whom we will coordinate your placement. For those who do not wish to attend DP Training's selected placement, you will have the opportunity to source your own alternative vocational work placement location in coordination with DP Training.

It is a requirement to obtain security clearance* before you can commence your placement. If you already have a security clearance*, please provide a copy with your enrolment. If not, you will need to apply for one upon course commencement.



RPL Delivery

- Designed for existing workers who are able to demonstrate that they have acquired the required knowledge and skills specified in the training package through formal, non-formal and informal learning
- If you consider yourself to already have the knowledge and skills for the qualification, any person currently working in the industry has the opportunity to apply for the Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessment-only pathway

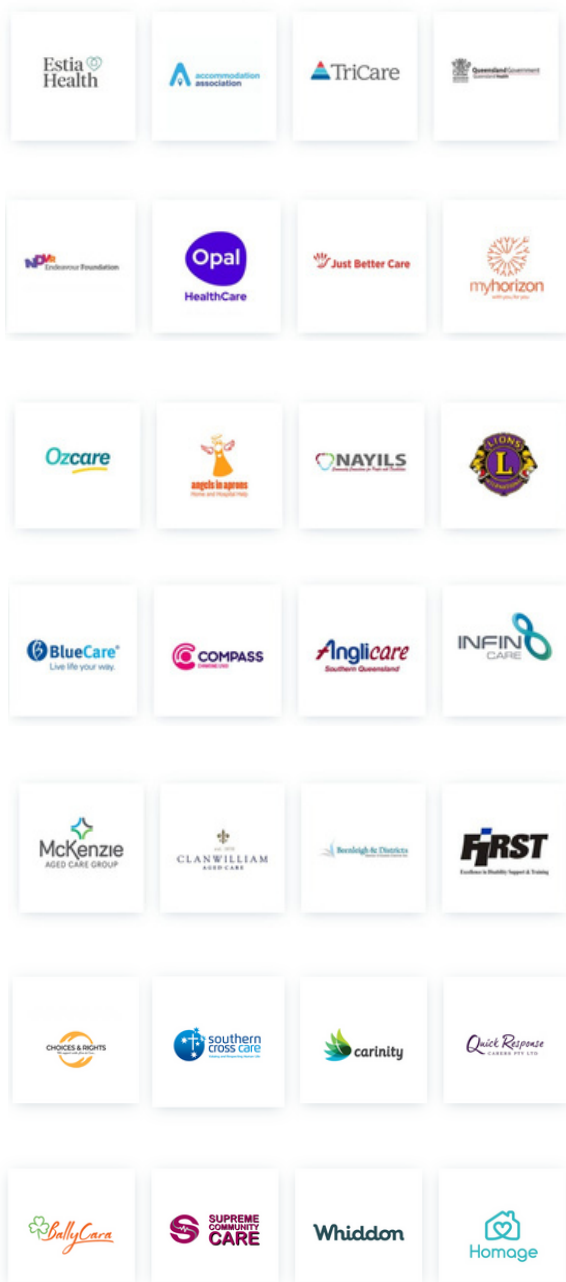
