- Students must meet the English Language Proficiency requirements: Academic IELTS 6 or equivalent.

Vocational Placement

Minimum 200 hours of vocational placement required at a relevant workplace. Placement may be voluntary work or paid employment in a relevant role.

Security Clearances: Some qualifications require a security clearance (e.g., police check, valid blue card and/or yellow card) in order for the student to be eligible to undertake practical and/or vocational placement. Additionally, individual host organisations may have different requirements regarding vaccinations.
