Entry Requirements

- Applicants must have completed year 12 schooling (or equivalent) and should be a minimum of 17 years of age at the time of application and must be 18 years of age at the commencement of the course.
- Students must meet the English Language Proficiency requirements: Academic IELTS 6 or equivalent.

Application Requirements

Prospective students must complete in FULL an <u>International Student Application</u> and <u>Statement of Purpose</u>, attaching ALL requisite supporting documentation.

Course Fees

Onshore students = \$8,600 (\$8,000 tuition + \$300 application fee + \$300 course material fee)

Offshore students = \$9,600 (\$9,000 tuition + \$300 application fee + \$300 course material fee).

Nominal Duration

Vocational Placement

Minimum 120 hours vocational placement required at a relevant workplace. Placement may be voluntary work or paid employment in a relevant role.

Security Clearances: Some qualifications require a security clearance (e.g., police check, valid blue card and/or yellow card) in order for the student to be eligible to undertake practical and/or vocational placement. Additionally, individual host organisations may have different requirements regarding vaccinations.
